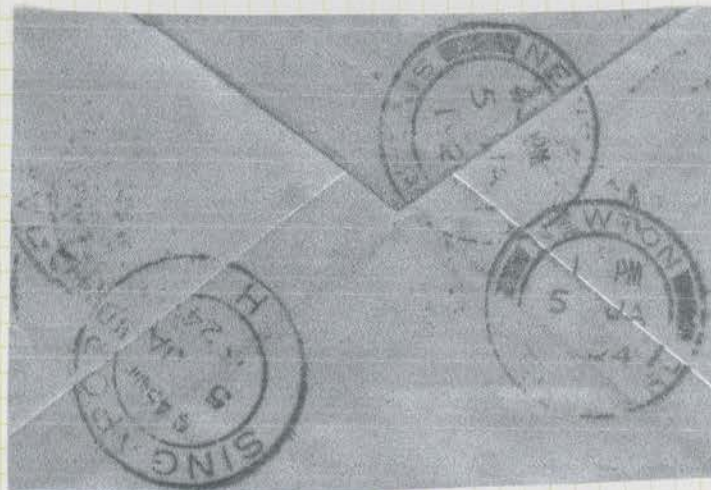


MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Singapore

November 1923/ January 1924

Underpaid letter from Los Angeles, USA to Singapore, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked NOV 27 1923 on a copy of the 2 cents of 1922. The rate was 5 cents and the deficiency 3 cents. There is also a "SeaTtle" "30/ centimes" (taxe) mark to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a Singapore arrival mark 5 JA 1924 and of Newton of the same day. On the obverse there is a copy of the 8 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp issued on 1 JAN 1924 postmarked Newton. The letter was however redirected within Singapore and the original postage due stamp received a "Charge not collected/ X/ Fresh Label required" mark. It also received departure and arrival marks of Newton and Singapore of the same day on the reverse. On the obverse it received another 8 cents postage due stamp postmarked in Singapore.

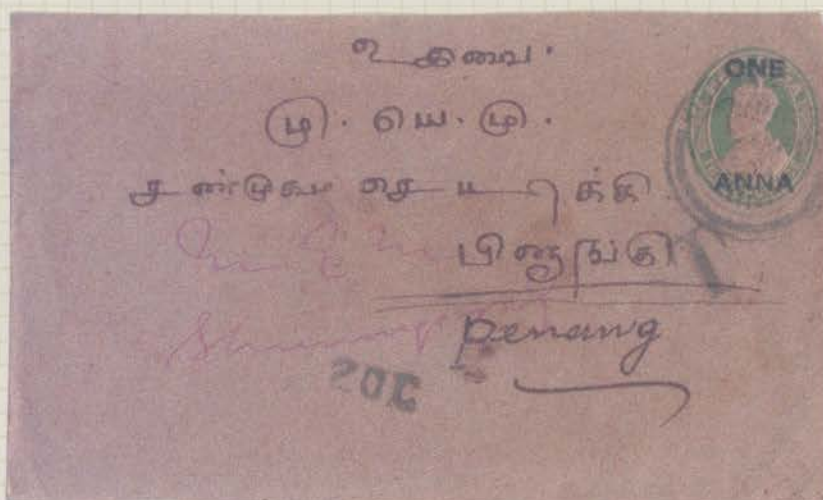


MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

February 1924

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna on ½ Anna) from Kilasavalpatti, India to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked on 1 FEB 24. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. Also on the obverse are Indian "T" (Taxe) and "20C" marks to denote double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a Penang arrival mark of 9 FE 1924 on a top marginal copy of the 8 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp newly released on 1 January 1924.

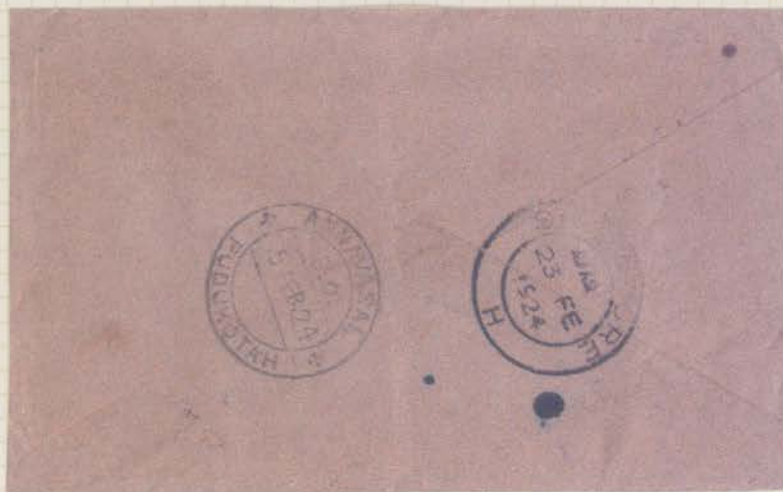


MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Singapore

February 1924

Unpaid letter from Annavasal, Pudukotah, India to Singapore, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 5 FEB 24 on the reverse. The rate and the deficiency was 2 Annas. On the obverse are Indian "T" (taxe) and "40c" marks to denote double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a Singapore arrival marking of 23 FE 1924 and on the obverse the cancellation of 25 FEB 1924 is on a copy of the newly issued 10 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

April 1924

Unpaid letter from Kandramanikam, India to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 12 APR 24 on the reverse. The rate and the deficiency was 2 Annas.

On the obverse are Indian "Kandramanikam/ due/ ...As" in a horseshoe, "T" (Taxe) and "40c" marks to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a faint Penang arrival mark on a marginal copy of the 10 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

April/May 1924

Underpaid letter from India to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya partly paid by copies of the ½ Anna and 1 Anna of 1911/22. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark and a manuscript "10c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse the Penang arrival mark of 3 MY 1924 is on a copy of the 8 cents postage due stamp of 1924.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

May 1924

Underpaid letter from Devakottai, India to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 22 May 24 on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1922 on the reverse. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse there are Indian "T" and "20.C" (Tax) marks to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a Penang arrival mark of 31 MY 1924 on a copy of an 8 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp of 1924.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

June 1924

Underpaid letter from Rangoon, Burma (then in India) to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 18 JUN.24 on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1911. The rate was 2 Annas, the deficiency 1 Anna and there is a Burmese "T" (Taxe) mark.

On the reverse the Penang arrival mark of 24 JU 1924 is on a copy of the 8 cents postage due stamp of 1924.

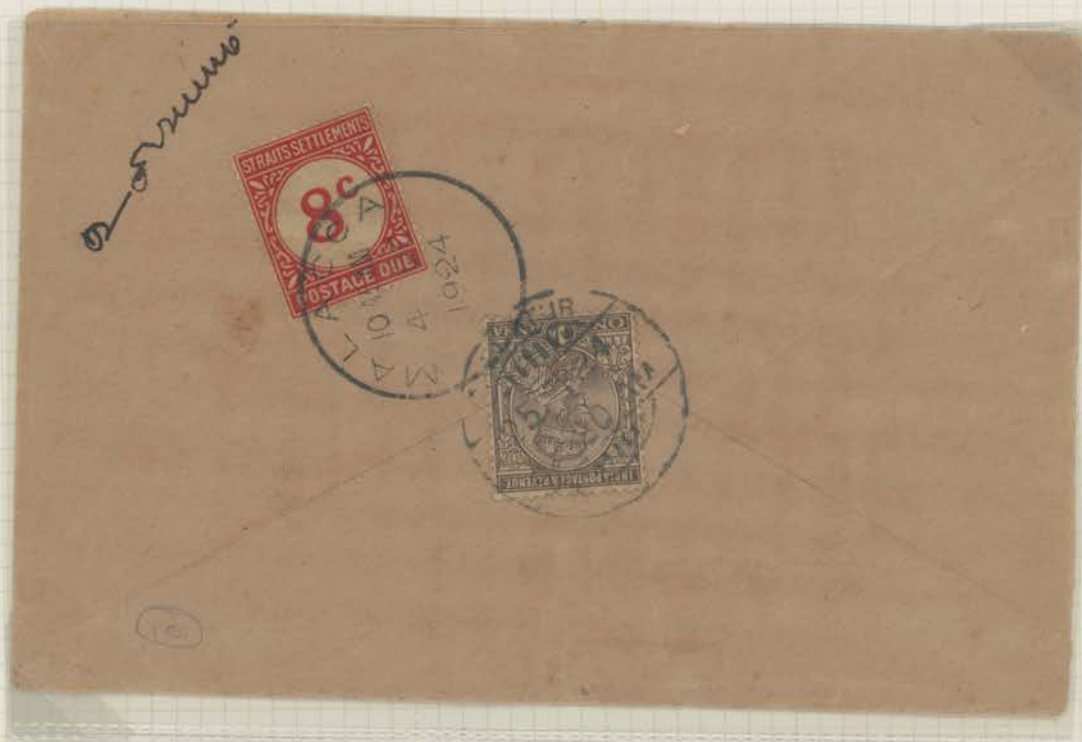


MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Malacca

September/October 1924

Underpaid letter from Pallatur, India to Malacca, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 25 SP 1924 on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1922 on the reverse. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse there is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark together with a "20.c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a Malacca arrival mark of 4 OC 1924 on a copy of the 8 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp of 1924.

MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Singapore

September/October 1924

Unpaid letter from Devakottai, India to Singapore, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 28 SEP 24 on the reverse. The rate and the deficiency was 2 Annas.

On the obverse are Indian "T" (Tax) and "40.C" marks to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes as well as a "Devakota/ due/ As" mark. On the reverse there are Singapore arrival marks of 14 OC 1924 and there is a further arrival mark on the obverse on a copy of the 10 cents postage due stamp of 1924.
