

MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

May 1927

Underpaid letter from temporary post office R-10, Burma to Butterworth, Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya with postage partly paid by a copy of the 1 Anna of 1926 postmarked 12 May on the reverse.

The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna.

On the obverse is a Burmese "T/ C/ 20" (Taxe) mark in a hexagon indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a transit mark of Penang of 23 MY 1927 and the arrival mark of Butterworth of 23 MY 1927 is on a copy of the 8 cents postage due stamp of 1924.

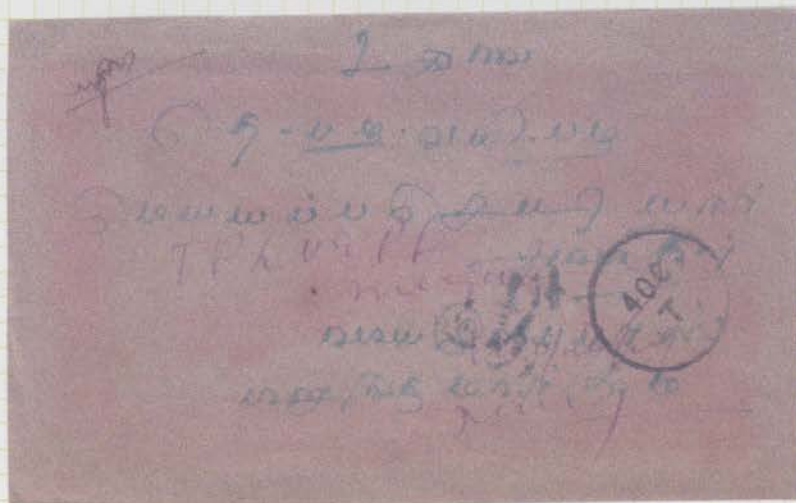
Penang

April 1927

Unpaid letter from Karaikudi, India to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 14 APR 27 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas.

On the obverse is an Indian "40C/T" (Tax) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes.

On the reverse the arrival mark of Penang of 22 AP 1927 is on a copy of the 12 cents postage due stamp of 1924.

August 1927

Unpaid letter from Kilasavalpatti, India to Butterworth, Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 11 AUG 27 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas. On the obverse is an Indian "40C/ T" (Tax) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Butterworth arrival mark on the reverse of 19 AU 1927 is on copies of the 2 cents and 10 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamps of 1924.

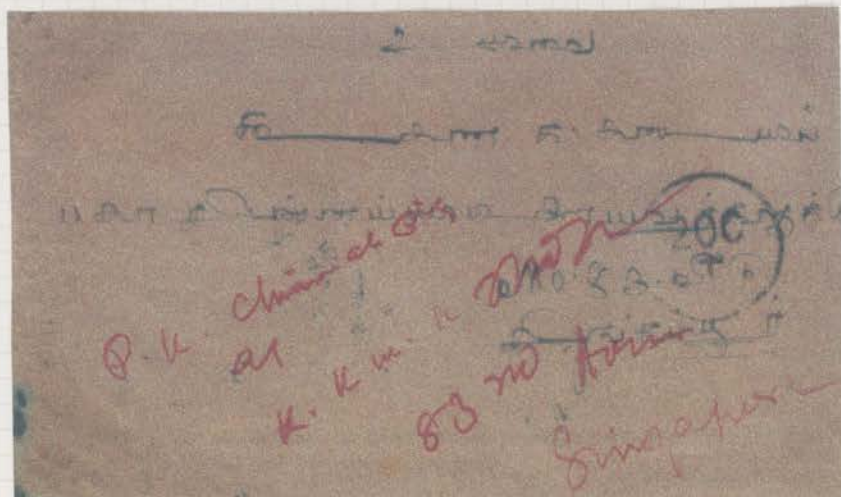


MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Singapore

August 1927

Underpaid letter from Melur, Madura, India to Singapore, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked on the reverse 17 AUG.27 on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1926. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse is an Indian "20C/T" (Taxe) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Singapore arrival mark on the reverse of 26 AU 1927 is on a copy of the 8 cents postage due stamp of 1924.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Singapore

September/October 1927

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna) from India to Singapore, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 27 SEP 27. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "20C/ T" (Taxe) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Singapore arrival mark of 1 OC 1927 is on a 8 cents Straits Settlements postage due stamp of 1924.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

November 1927

Indian KGV PSE (inland rate of 1 Anna) postmarked 1 NOV 27 from to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "20C/T" (Taxe) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Penang arrival mark of 11 NO 1927 is on a copy of the 8 cents postage due stamp of 1924 on the reverse.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Penang

November 1927

Unpaid letter from Karaikudi, India to Penang, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 18 NOV.27 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas.

On the obverse is an Indian "40C/ T" (Taxe) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes as well as a semi-circular "Karaikudi/ Due/ As" mark. The Penang arrival mark of 25 NO 1927 is on a copy of the 12 cents postage due stamp of 1924 on the reverse.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Singapore

December 1927/ January 1928

Unpaid letter from Paganeri, India to Singapore, Straits Settlements, Malaya postmarked 30 DEC.27 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas.

On the obverse is an Indian "40C/ T" (Taxe) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes as well as a semi-circular "Paganeri/ Due/ Two Annas" mark. The Singapore arrival mark on the reverse of 7 JA 1928 is on a copy of the 12 cents postage due stamp of 1924 (SGD6).
