

MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

June/August 1909

Underpaid letter from Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya to Lima, Peru postmarked 14 JU 1909 on a copy of the 3 cents of 1909. The rate was 8 cents (as written in pencil on the top of the letter) and the deficiency was 5 cents.

There is also a Kuala Lumpur "kTI" (Taxe) mark in a triangle as well as a blue manuscript "1/20c" to denote the first weight step and double the deficiency in French centimes. There is a large violet mark **MULADA** (Spanish for fined). On the reverse there is a transit mark of Penang of June 16 1909. Also on the reverse is a Peruvian machine arrival mark of AGO 19 09 and, on a copy of the 5 centavos and a strip of 3 of the 1 centavo postage due stamps of 1909 with a postmark of Lima on AGO 20 1909.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

July/August 1909

Underpaid letter from Ipoh, Perak, Malaya to Stockholm, Sweden postmarked on 27 July 1909 on copies of the 1 and 3 cents of 1909. The rate was 8 cents and the deficiency was 4 cents.

There is also an Ipoh "iTp" (Taxe) mark in an inverted triangle as well as a blue manuscript "1/20c" to denote the first weight step and double the deficiency in French centimes. There is a transit mark of Penang of 29 July on the reverse as well as Sassnitz-Trelleborg railway ferry marine sorter of 22 August and a Stockholm arrival mark of 23 August. On the obverse there is a Swedish "Losen ... ore" in violet with a blue manuscript "16" inserted to denote the postage due collected.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak via Penang

August 1909

Underpaid PPC (*Club and Padang, Ipoh*) from Ipoh, Perak, Malaya to Resses, Gard, France postmarked 2 August 1909 on a pair of the 1 cent of 1908 on the obverse. The rate was 3 cents and the deficiency was 1 cent.

There is a Taiping transit mark of 2 August 1909 and "tTp" (Taxe) mark in an inverted triangle. In transit in Penang it received a transit mark of 3 August 1909. A Resses arrival mark of 26 August 1909 is on a copy of the French 5 centimes postage due stamp of 1893.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor via Penang

December 1909

Underpaid PPC (*Java village*) from Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Federated Malay States, Malaya to London, England partly paid by a horizontal pair of the 1 cent of 1908 postmarked 25 December 1909. There is a transit mark of 6pm on 26 December 1909 of Penang. The rate was 3 cents and the deficiency 1 cent. There is also a Kuala Lumpur "KT1" (Tax) mark in a triangle as well as a blue manuscript "1/5c" to denote the weight step and double the deficiency in French centimes. There is a London postage due large mark of "1/2 d / F.B." to denote the postage due collectable.



MALAYA – FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak via Penang

July/August 1910

Underpaid ppc (Kuala Kangsar Show) from Taiping, Perak, Malaya to London, England. Postage is partly paid by a copy of the 1 cent Federated Malay States of 1908 postmarked on 29 JY 1910.

The rate was 3 cents, and the deficiency 2 cents.

There is also a Taiping "tTp" (Taxe) mark in an inverted triangle as well as a blue manuscript "10c" to denote double the deficiency in French centimes. There is a Penang transit mark of 30 JY 1910.

There is an arrival mark of London W.C. of AU 22 10 as well as a postage due mark of "1d/ F.B." to denote the postage due collected.

FEDERATED MALAY STATES - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

Selangor via Penang

November 1910

Underpaid PPC (KL Government Offices) from Kuala Lumpur, Selangor to the USA postmarked 20 November 1910 on 2 copies of the FMS 1 cent of 1908. The rate was 3 cents the deficiency 1 cent. There is a Kuala Lumpur "kTI" (tax) mark plus a blue manuscript "T 10c". There is a transit mark of Penang of 8am on 21 November 1910. On arrival in New York a "New York Hud Term" Due 2 cents" mark of 23 December 1910 was applied to denote the postage due.



FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

November/December 1910

Underpaid PPC (*Funeral of Eu Tong Swee*) from Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya to Petersburg, USA partly paid by two copies of the FMS one cent of 1908 postmarked 18 NO 1910.

The rate was 3 cents and the deficiency was one cent.

There is a Kuala Lumpur "kTI" (Tax) mark in a triangle and a blue manuscript "10c" to indicate double the deficiency in French centimes. There is a Penang transit mark of 21 NO 1910. On arrival two US 2 cent postage due stamps were applied postmarked DEC 26, a transit period of 38 days.
