

MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

August 1919

Underpaid letter from Kilasavalpatti, India to Taiping, Perak, Malaya postmarked 12 AUG. 19 on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1911 on the reverse. The rate was 1½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna. On the obverse is an Indian "T" (Tax) mark. On the reverse is a Taiping arrival mark of 21 AU 1919 and a "T Cents 4" mark indicating that postage due of 4 cents was charged.



MALAYA - STRAITS SETTLEMENTS - SELANGOR

Singapore to Selangor

August 1919

Underpaid letter from Singapore, Straits Settlements to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 18 AU 1919 on a copy of the 3 cents of 1917 on the reverse. The rate was 4 cents, the deficiency 1 cent, and double that 2 cents.

The Kuala Lumpur arrival mark on the reverse is 19 AU 1919. On the obverse is a large blue manuscript "2" indicating that postage due of 2 cents was charged.



Perak

August/September 1919

Underpaid PSC (1918 local rate of ¼ Anna) from India to Teluk Anson, Perak, Malaya partly uprated with the 3 Pies of 1912 postmarked 16 August 1919. The rate was 1 Anna and the deficiency ½ Anna. There is an Indian "T" (Tax) mark with a manuscript "10c" to show double the deficiency in French centimes.

There is an Ipoh transit mark of 7 September 1919. The arrival mark of Teluk Anson is 9 September 1919 and there is also a "T 4C" tax mark in a circle indicating that postage due of 4 cents was charged.

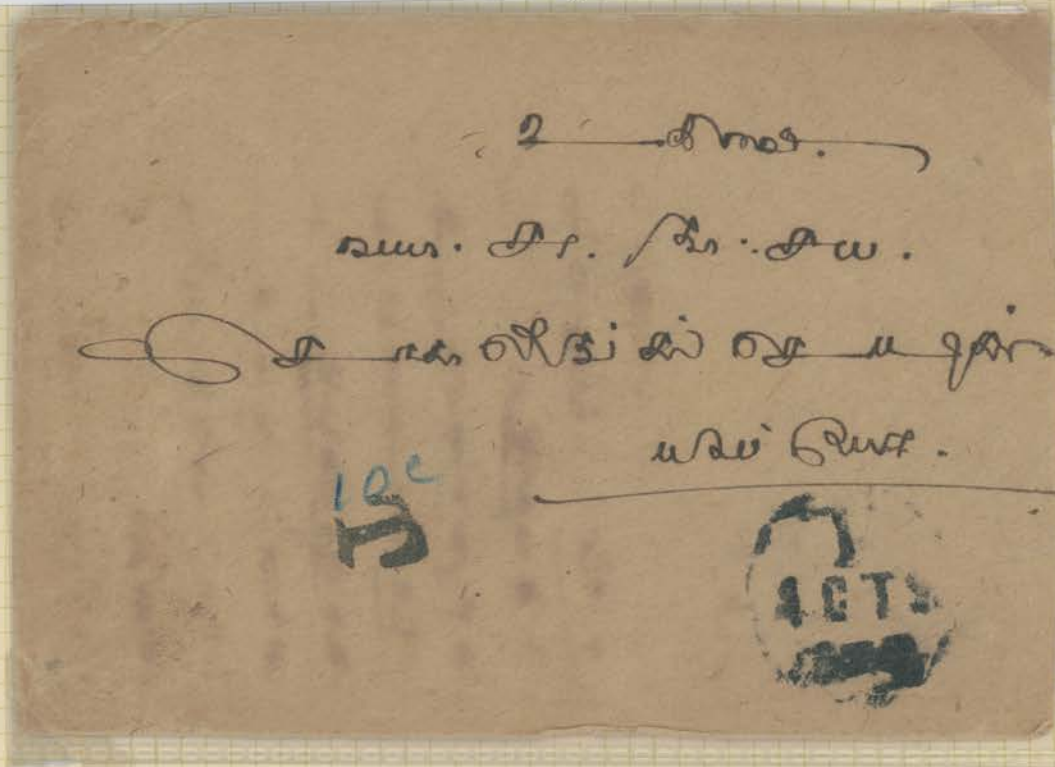
MALAYA - PERAK

Perak

September/October 1919

Underpaid letter from Colombo, Ceylon to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya postmarked SP 23 19 on the reverse on a copy of the 6 cents of 1912. The rate was 9 cents and the deficiency 3 cents.

On the obverse is a Ceylon "T" (Taxe) mark and a manuscript marking in blue of "10c" being double the deficiency in French centimes. The Ipoh arrival mark of 8 October 1919 is on the reverse. On the obverse is an Ipoh postage due marking in a circle "T/ 4 Cts" indicating that postage due of 4 cents was charged.

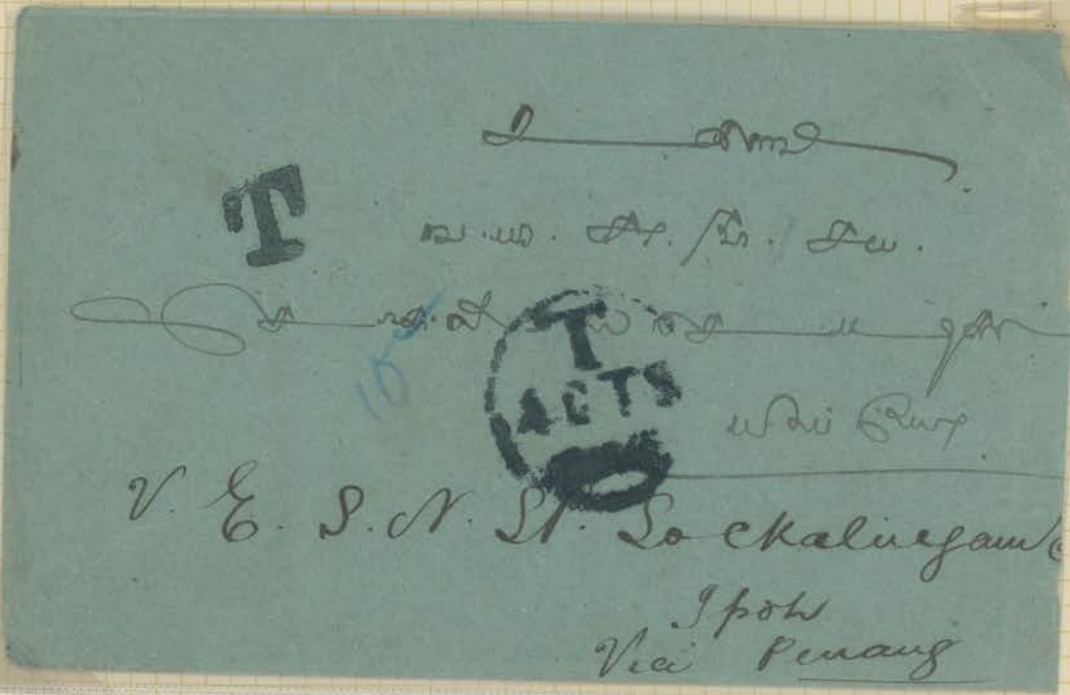


MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

September/October 1919

Underpaid letter from Petta..., Ceylon to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya postmarked SE 29 19 on a copy of the 6 cents of 1912 on the reverse. The rate was 9 cents and the deficiency 3 cents. On the obverse is a Ceylon "T" (Taxe) mark together with a manuscript in blue of 10c being double the deficiency in French centimes. The faint Ipoh arrival mark is 8 OC 1919 is on the reverse. Also on the obverse is an Ipoh postage due mark in a circle "T/ 4 Cts" indicating that postage due of 4 cents was charged.

Perak

December 1919/January 1920

Underpaid letter from Kilpauk..., India to Sitiawan, Perak, Malaya postmarked 16 DEC 19 on the reverse on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1911. The rate was 1½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna. On the obverse is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark. On the reverse there is a manuscript "10c" denoting double the deficiency in French centimes. There is a transit mark of Taiping of 6 JA 1920 and a boxed postage due mark "T cents 4" indicating that postage due of 4 cents was charged. There is also a Sitiawan arrival mark of 8 January 1920.

Negri Sembilan

April 1920

Indian KGV Postal Stationary envelope (internal rate of ½ Anna) from Pudu..., India to Seremban, Negri Sembilan, Malaya postmarked 25 APR 20. The rate was 1½ Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. Also on the obverse is an Indian "T" (Tax) mark and a Seremban mark "T/SBN 8 cents/to pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was charged. On the reverse there is an indistinct Seremban arrival mark.

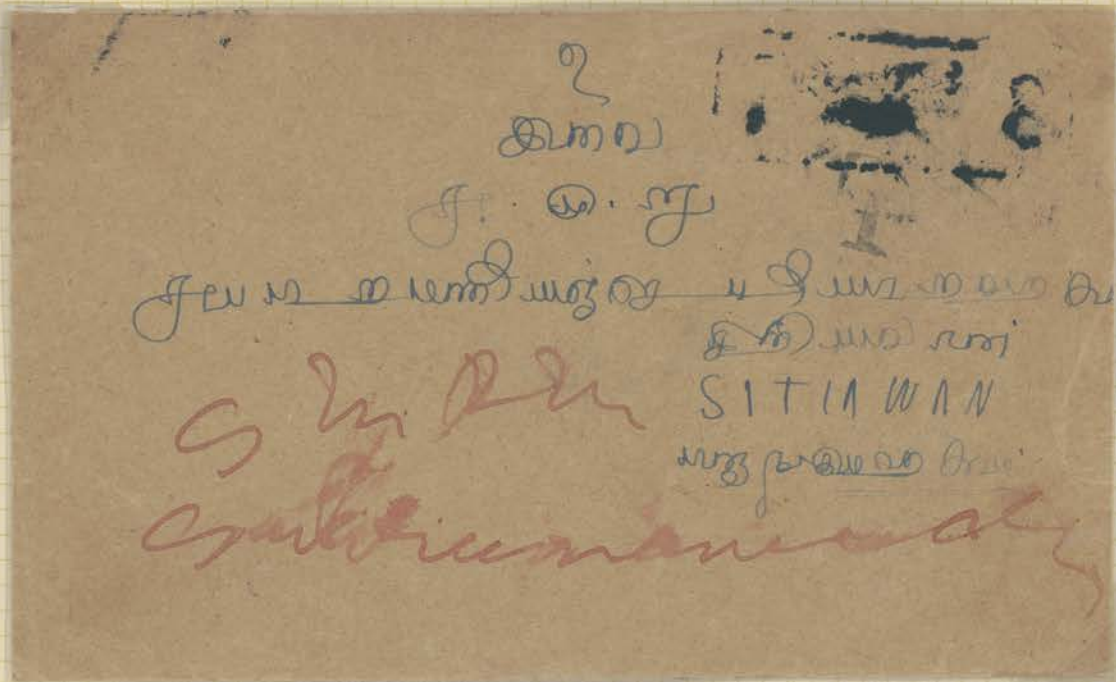


MALAYA - PERAK

Perak

May/June 1920

Underpaid letter from ...kondan-Siruvaya, India to Sitiawan, Perak, Malaya postmarked 18 MY 20 on the reverse on a copy of the ½ Anna of 1912. The rate was 1½ Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the reverse there is a Taiping transit mark of 31 MY 1920 and a boxed postage due mark "T cents 8" on the obverse indicating that postage due of 8 cents was to be charged. The Sitiawan arrival mark is 2 JU 1920.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Negri Sembilan

June/July 1920

Underpaid letter from Palladam, India to Seremban, Negri Sembilan, Malaya postmarked 24 JUN 20 on a copy of the 1 Anna of 1911. There is also an Indian "T" mark on the obverse.

The rate was 1½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna.

The Seremban arrival mark on the reverse is 5 JY 1920 and on the obverse is a boxed postage due mark "T 4 cents/ SBN to pay" indicating that postage due of 4 cents was charged.
