

MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

May 1923

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of ½ Anna uprated to 1 Anna) from Devakota, India to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya postmarked 15 MAY 23. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse there is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark and a manuscript "20c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is an Ipoh arrival mark of 27 MY 1923 and a boxed postage due mark "Ipoh / 8 Cts. / To pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was charged.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

May 1923

Unpaid letter from Kandramanikam, India to Klang, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 5 MAY.23 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas.

On the obverse there is an Indian "T" (Tax) mark and a manuscript "40c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes as well as a boxed transit postage due mark "Kuala Lumpur/ 10 Cts./ To pay" indicating that postage due of 10 cents was charged. On the reverse there is an "FMS Selangor" railway sorting van mark of 19 MY 1923 and a Klang arrival mark of 22 MY 1923.



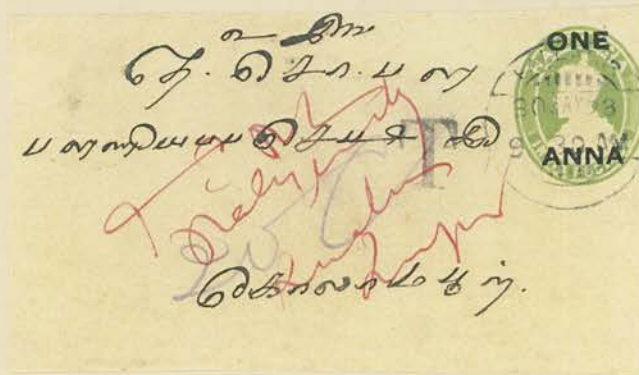
MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

May/June 1923

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of ½ Anna uprated to 1 Anna) from India to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 30 May 1923. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna.

On the obverse is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark and a manuscript "20c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is a Kuala Lumpur arrival mark of 15 June 1923 and a boxed violet postage due mark "Kuala Lumpur/ 8 Cts./ To pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was charged.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Negri Sembilan

June 1923

Underpaid PSE (local letter rate of 1 Anna partly uprated with a copy of the ½ Anna of 1911 on the reverse) from Madras, India to Seremban, Negri Sembilan, Malaya postmarked 14 June 1923.

The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna.

On the obverse there is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark with a manuscript "10c" to denote double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is an arrival mark of Seremban of 30 June 1923 and a purple boxed postage due mark "Seremban/ 8 Cts./ To pay" indicating the postage due was charged.



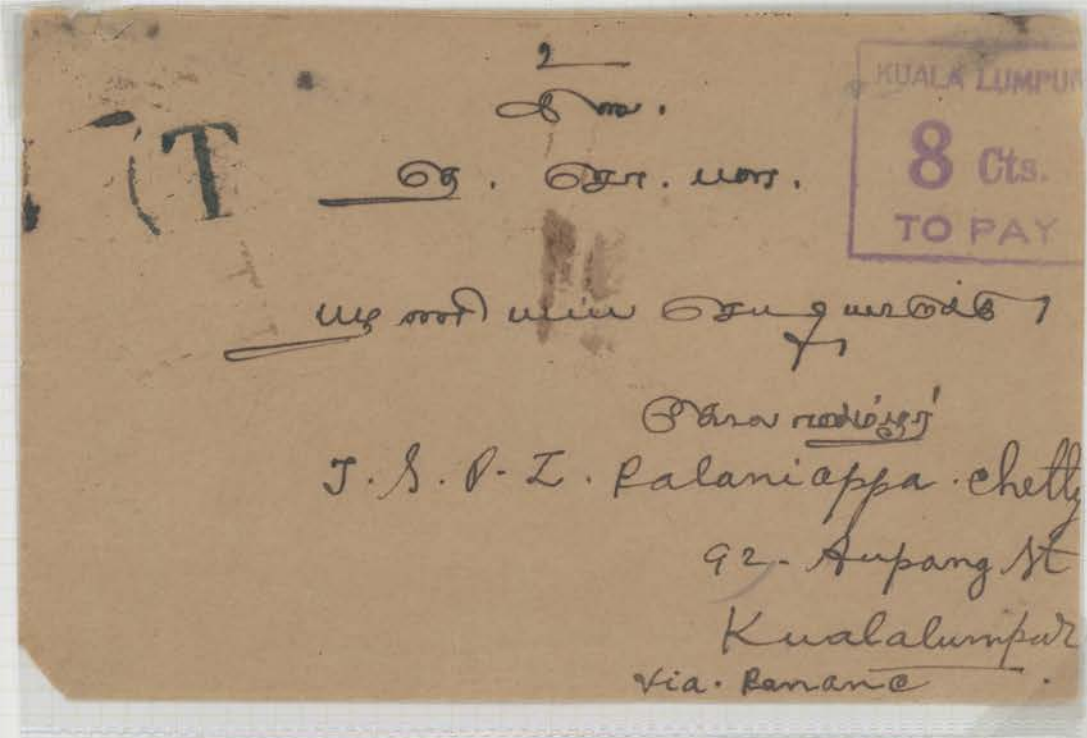
MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor/Straits Settlements

June/July 1923

Underpaid letter from Rangoon, Burma to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 27 JUN 23 on the reverse on a copy of the Indian 1 Anna of 1911. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna.

On the obverse there is a Burmese "T" (Tax) mark. On the reverse there is a Penang, Straits Settlements, transit mark of 2 JY 1923. On the obverse there is a boxed postage due mark "Kuala Lumpur/ 8 Cts./ To pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was charged.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

July 1923

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna) from Rangoon, Burma to Taiping, Perak, Malaya postmarked 5 JULY 23. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse is a Burmese "T" (Tax) mark. On the reverse there is a Penang transit mark and a violet boxed postage due mark "Taiping/ 8 Cts./ To pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was charged.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Negri Sembilan

August 1923

Underpaid letter from Nachanoupatti, India to Seremban, Negri Sembilan, Malaya postmarked 12 AU 23 on three copies of the ½ Anna of 1911. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark with a manuscript "10c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes and a Seremban boxed postage due mark "Seremban/ 8 Cts./ To pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was charged. On the reverse there is a Seremban arrival mark of 26 AU 1923.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

August/September 1923

Unpaid letter from Karaikudi, India to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya postmarked 22 August 1923 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas. On the obverse is an Indian "T" (Tax) mark with a manuscript "40c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes.

On the reverse there is an Ipoh arrival mark of 8 September 1923 and a boxed postage due mark "Ipoh/ 10 cents/ To pay" indicating the postage due to be charged.



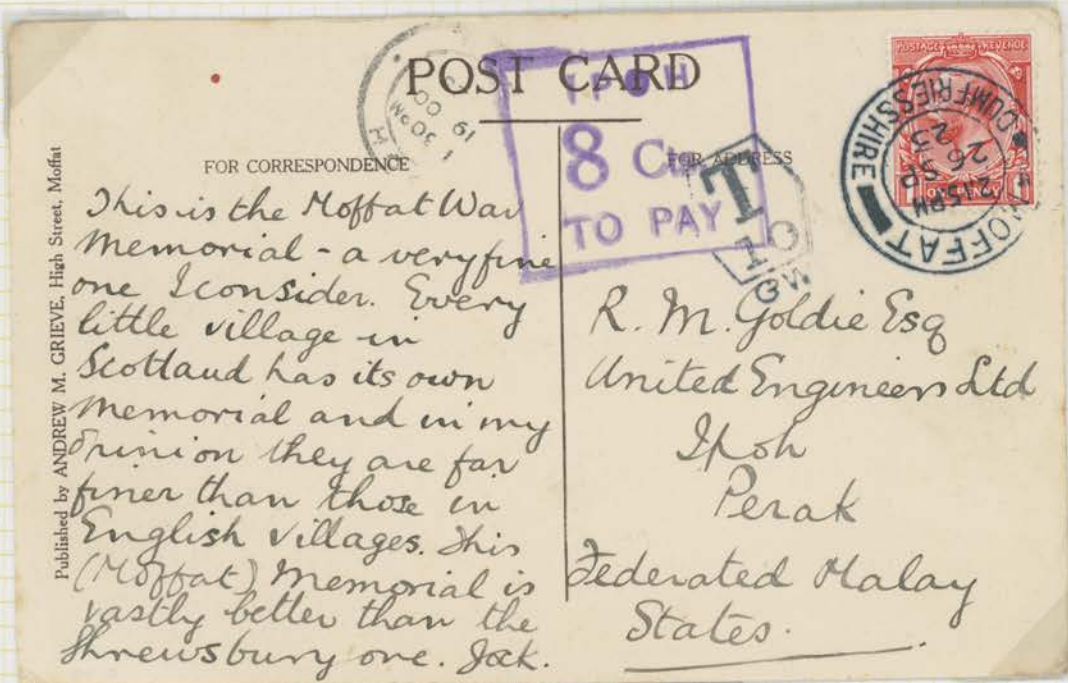
MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

September/ October 1923

Underpaid PPC (*Moffat war memorial*) from Moffat, Scotland postmarked 26 SP 23 to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya. The rate was 1½d and the deficiency ½d.

There is a Glasgow "T/10/GW" (Taxe) mark to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes, an Ipoh arrival mark of 19 OC 1923 and a boxed postage due "Ipoh/ 8 Cts./ To pay" mark showing postage due.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

September/ October 1923

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna) from Madras, India to Kampar, Perak, Malaya postmarked 28 SEP 23. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna

On the obverse is an Indian "T" (Taxe) mark and a manuscript "20c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there are Ipoh and Kampar transit and arrival marks of 6 OC 1923 and 8 OC 1923. On the obverse there is a boxed "Ipoh/ 8 Cts./ To pay" mark indicating postage due.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

November 1923

Underpaid letter from Devakottai, India to Teluk Anson, Perak, Malaya postmarked 2 NOV 23 on four copies of the 3 Pies of 1911 on the reverse. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse is an Indian "T" (Tax) mark next to a manuscript "20c" to indicate double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is an Ipoh, transit mark of 16 NO 1923 and a boxed postage due mark "Ipoh/ 8 Cts./ To pay" indicating that postage due of 8 cents was to be charged. There is a partial Teluk Anson arrival mark (normally used for registered mail) of 17 NO 1923.
