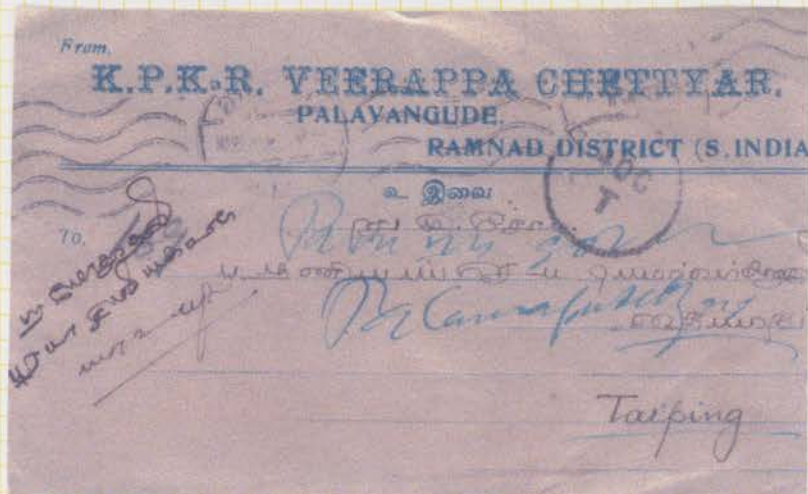


# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

September 1930

Unpaid letter from Palayangude, Ramnad, India to Taiping, Perak, Malaya postmarked 19 SEP.30 with an Indian transit mark of the same day both on the reverse. The rate and deficiency was 2 Annas. On the obverse is an Indian "40C/T" (Taxe) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse the Taiping machine arrival mark is 26 SEP 30 and a copy of the 12 cents postage due stamp of 1924 postmarked 27 SP 1930.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

February/March 1931

Unpaid letter from Morcambe, Lancaster, England to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 11 February 1931. The rate and the deficiency was 1½d.

There is a Manchester "T/ 20/ M.R." (Taxe) transit mark which has been changed to 30 correctly indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Kuala Lumpur arrival mark is 8 March 1931 on a copy of the 12 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1924.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

May 1931

Unpaid letter from Utan Melintang to Ipoh, Perak. Malaya postmarked 13 May 1931. The rate and the deficiency was 4 cents. There is a "uTm/ cts" (Taxe) mark in a circle with a "08" inserted in manuscript. On the reverse there is a Telok Anson transit mark of 13 May 1931. The Ipoh arrival mark of 14 May 1931 is on a copy if the FMS 8 cents postage due stamp of 1924.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

June 1931

Underpaid letter from Shanghai, China to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya partly paid by copies of the 10 cents, 3 cents on 4 cents and a pair of the 1 cent on 3 cents of 1923/30 postmarked 2.6.31.

The rate was 20 cents and the deficiency 5 cents.

On the obverse is a Shanghai "ShanTghai" (Taxe) mark in a circle and a red boxed "T 12 ½ ctms." indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Kuala Lumpur arrival mark of 16 JU 1931 is on the reverse on copies of the 2 cents and 4 cents FMS postage due stamps of 1924/26.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

July/August 1931

Underpaid PSE (1 Anna internal rate) from Kailukkatti, India to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 10 JLY31. The rate was 2 Annas and the deficiency 1 Anna. On the obverse is an Indian "20 C/ T" in a circle (Tax) mark indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Kuala Lumpur arrival mark, of JUL 1931 is on copies of the 2 cents and 4 cents FMS postage due stamps of 1924/26.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Negri Sembilan

September 1931

Unpaid letter from Kuruvikondanpatti, Pudukotah, India to Seremban, Negri Sembilan, Malaya postmarked 17 SEP.31 on the reverse. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 Annas.

On the obverse there is an Indian "40C/ T" mark in a circle to denote double the deficiency in gold centimes and an arrival mark of 26 SE 1931 on a copy of the 12 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1924.

The same Seremban arrival mark of the same day is on the reverse.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

October 1931

Unpaid printed matter item from Ipoh to Taiping, Perak, Malaya postmarked 21 October 1931. The rate, and the deficiency, was 2 cents. There is also an Ipoh "I T P/ cts" (tax) mark in a circle. On the reverse there is a Taiping arrival mark of 22 October 1931. There is also a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926 postmarked the same day.



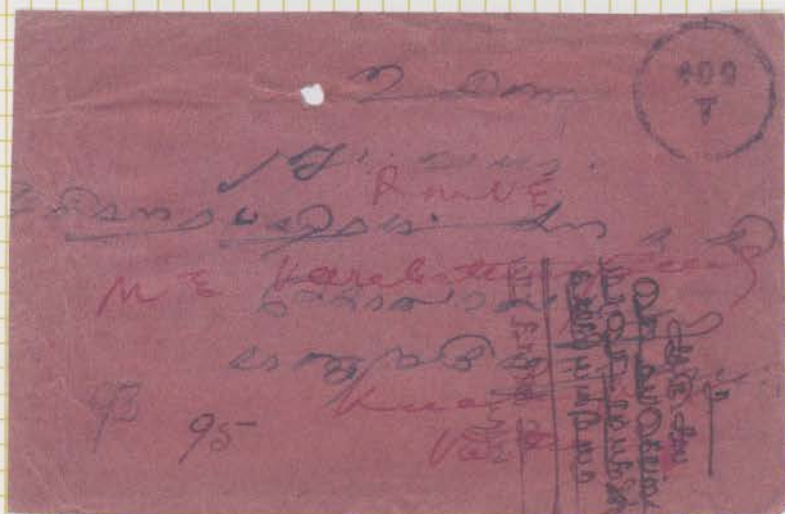
# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

November/December 1931

Unpaid letter from Givaganga, India to Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Malaya postmarked 30 NOV.31 on the reverse. The rate and the deficiency was 2 Annas

On the obverse is an Indian "40C/T" (Tax) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Kuala Lumpur arrival mark of 13 DE 1931 is on a copy of the 12 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1924.





# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Selangor

December 1931

Underpaid letter from Pattamangalam, India to Klang, Selangor, Malaya partly paid by two copies of the 1 Anna of 1926 postmarked 9 DEC.31. The rate was 2½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna. Also on the obverse is an Indian "c/T" (Taxe) mark in a circle and a manuscript "10c" indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. There is a transit mark of Kandramanikam of 9 DEC.31 on the reverse and a Klang arrival mark of 19 DE 1931 on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.



# MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

## Negri Sembilan

December 1931/ January 1932

Underpaid letter from Negapatam, India to Seremban, Negri Sembilan, Malaya partly paid by a horizontal pair of the 1 Anna and one copy of the 3 Pies of 1926 postmarked 26 DEC.31 on the reverse. The rate was  $2\frac{1}{2}$  Annas and the deficiency  $\frac{1}{4}$  Anna.

On the obverse is an Indian "c/T" (Tax) mark in a circle and a manuscript "10c" to denote double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse the Seremban arrival mark of 2 JA 1932 is on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.
