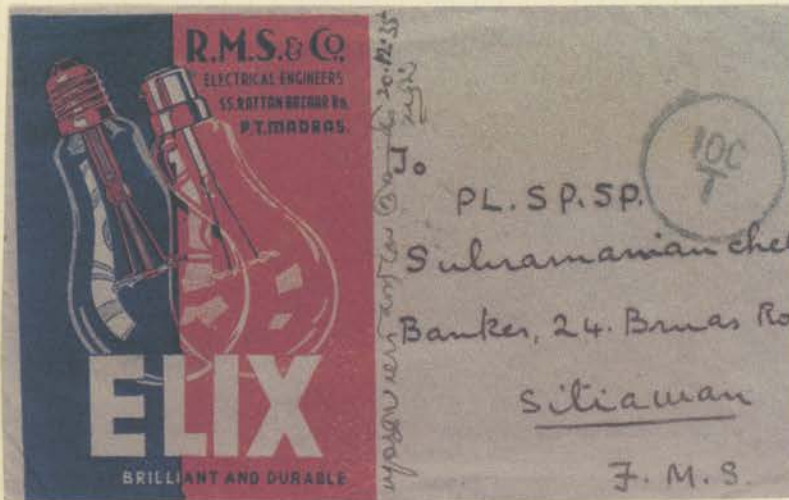


MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

December 1935

Underpaid envelope (for "Elix" light bulbs) from India to Sitiawan, Perak, Malaya partly paid by pair of the 1 Anna of 1926 postmarked 3 DEC.35 on the reverse. The rate was $2\frac{1}{2}$ Annas, the deficiency $\frac{1}{2}$ Anna. On the obverse there is an Indian "10C/T" (Taxe) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse the Sitiawan arrival mark of 13 DE 1935 is on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

December 1935

Underpaid letter from Karikal, French Indian Settlements to Taiping, Perak, Malaya partly paid by two copies of the Indian 1 Anna of 1926 postmarked 19 DEC.35 on the reverse. The rate was $2\frac{1}{2}$ Annas and the deficiency $\frac{1}{2}$ Anna.

On the obverse is an Indian "10C/T" (Tax) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse the Taiping arrival mark of 27 DE 1935 is on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.



FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

February 1936

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna) from Tiruchengodu, India to Teluk Anson, Perak, Malaya partly uprated with a copy of the 1 Anna of 1934 on the reverse postmarked 18 FEB.36. The rate was 2½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "10/ T/ C" (Tax) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Teluk Anson arrival mark on the reverse of 28 FE 1936 is on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.

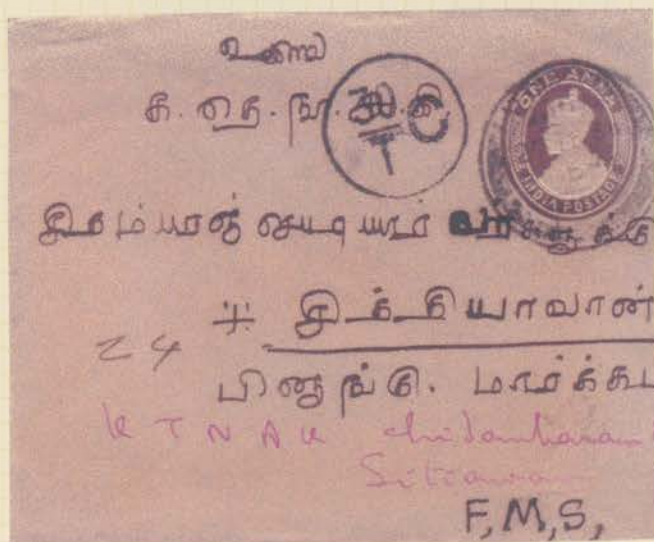
Perak

February/March 1936

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna) from India to Sitiawan, Perak, Malaya postmarked 27 FEB.36.

The rate was 2½ Annas and the deficiency 1½ Annas.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "30/ T/ C" (Taxe) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Sitiawan arrival mark on the reverse of 6 MR 1936 is on a copy of the 12 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1924.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

February/March 1936

Underpaid letter from Karaikudi, India to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya postmarked ?February 1936 on a pair of the 1 Anna of 1926. The rate was 2½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "10/ T/ C" (Tax) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Ipoh arrival mark on the reverse of 6 March 1936 is on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

March/April 1936

Indian KGV PSE (internal rate of 1 Anna) from Vallipalayam, India initially to Tapah, Perak, Malaya postmarked 19 MAR.36 with a transit mark of Tiruchengodu of the same day on the reverse. The rate was 2½ Annas and the deficiency 1½ Annas.

Also on the obverse is an Indian "T/ 30" (Tax) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. The Tapah arrival mark on the reverse of 31 MAR 1936 is on a copy of the 12 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1924. The letter was redirected to Teluk Anson and the postage due stamp was cancelled by an unrecorded boxed "Charge Not Collected/ X/ Fresh Label Required" mark of Tapah.

On arrival in Teluk Anson a new 12 cent due stamp was applied and postmarked on 2 APR 1936.

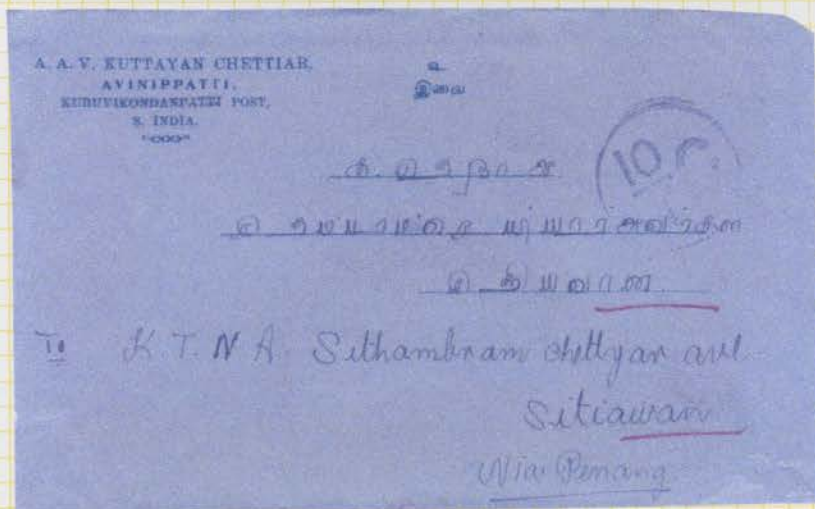


MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

July 1936

Underpaid cover from Avanipatti, India to Sitiawan, Perak, Malaya partly paid on the reverse with a pair of the 1 Anna of 1934 postmarked 16 JLY.36. The rate was 2½ Annas and the deficiency ½ Anna. On the obverse there is an Indian "10/T C" (Taxe) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes. On the reverse there is an Indian transit mark of KilasaValpatti of 16 JLY.36 and the Sitiawan arrival mark of 24 July 1936 is on a copy of the 4 cents FMS postage due stamp of 1926.



MALAYA - FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Perak

September 1936

Underpaid letter from Kandavarayanpatti, Ramnad, India to Ipoh, Perak, Malaya postmarked 9 September 1936 on the reverse on a pair of the 1/2 Anna of 1934. The rate was 2 1/2 Annas and the deficiency 1 1/2 Annas.

On the obverse is an Indian "30 C / T" (Taxe) mark in a circle indicating double the deficiency in gold centimes as well as a domestic semi-circular "Tiruppattu.. / Due / As". The Ipoh arrival mark on the reverse of 17 September 1936 is on a copy of the 12 cents Federated Malay States postage due stamp of 1924.
