
Demise of UK Postage Due Stamps – Rise of Self-Adhesive Labels & Cards From 1990s

Purpose – To illustrate the changes in collection of postage due from householders and small businesses as UK Post Office gradually eliminated use of postage due stamps from early 1990s.

Collecting postage due on the doorstep using postage due stamps was unpopular with public and postal delivery workers.

Several experiments in early 1990s before a system became standard using self-adhesive labels and cards to notify customers.



Background

5 Apr 1983 - end of double deficiency postage due. New system DEFICIENCY PLUS HANDLING FEE.

In 1992 Royal Mail national steering committee on improvement. Several experiments in different areas.

Spring 1993 York experiment:

Cards sent to notify that underpaid item was being held.


Customer attached stamps to pay deficiency and mailed to PO.

PO cancelled stamps and delivered the mail item.

1994 Royal Mail North East Receipts

These may be from continuation of York experiment or similar scheme.

No reports of these seen in philatelic press.

Feb 1994 to Bradford

Poor meter impression treated as 19p 2nd Class rate unpaid.

Dispatching office **SURCHARGED** mark




1991-93 Experimental Self-Adhesive Revenue Protection Labels

1991 to 1993 several dispatching offices tried applying self-adhesive Revenue Protection labels to underpaid mail – a more visible alternative to Surcharge handstamps. Delivery Offices still used postage due stamps to collect the charge.

6 Aug 1991 Early Yellow Bournemouth label with 13p Handling Fee

3 Sep1993 Yellow label, no office name, from Dorchester with 14p Handling Fee, 18p 2nd Class Rate Unpaid







Early Notification Cards

New system based on York experiment used cards to notify addressees that underpaid mail was being held awaiting payment of postage due. This system did not require postmen (women) to collect postage due on the doorstop and did not need the use of postage due stamps.




Handstamp at top repeats message that correct change is required.

P739 Card Sep 94 printing

From at least the 1970s P739 card notified failure to deliver. Used for many reasons e.g. "signature required", "too big for letter box".

Many offices used P739 for items being held for postage due under the new hold and notify system.

12 Sep 1997 Used at Cirencester.

New P4605 Card Aug 94 printing

New P4605 card introduced for items being held for postage due under hold and notify system.

22 Sep 1997 Used at Brixton

Brixton Delivery Office details on back (70% full size).







28 Jan 2000 Last Day of Postage Due Labels

Use of self-adhesive labels and notice cards increased through the 1990s – Use of postage due stamps declined. Postage due stamps continued in use at some offices until officially withdrawn on 29 Jan 2000.

Re: SURCHARGE SLOGAN

Thank you for your letter of October 14th 2004 regarding the surcharge slogan that we apply to some underpaid letters. Unfortunately, we do not produce examples of this slogan for philatelic use. It is only applied to live mail that meets the criteria to have the slogan applied. In case it is of interest, the criteria for this slogan to be applied are:

- 1) The item must be capable of being franked by a stamp-cancelling machine and weigh less than 60 grams
- 2) The item must have been posted in the catchment area for Glasgow Mail Centre (postcode areas: FK; G; HS; KA; ML; and PA) and must be for delivery in the following postcode areas: G (except G63); KA; ML; PA (only PA1-20; 22-27; 28; 34 & 37) or FK (only FK1; 2; 5 and 7-9)

Items that have been franked with this slogan are transmitted directly to the relevant local delivery office within a yellow surcharge pouch. Not all of our local delivery offices receive sufficient surcharges to justify having a pouch – hence the fact that only some of the PA and FK areas are covered.

To save time in changing over the die-head in the stamp-cancelling machine, we often use the slogan for items for delivery outwith the areas specified above. All such items, however, are then over labelled with the standard yellow surcharge sticker: this would appear to be what happened to the item that you posted in Glasgow.

21 Aug 2006 PiP Introduced

Price depended on size as well as weight.

21 Aug 2006 to about Feb 2007


Items underpaid because of size not charged postage due.



Pricing in Proportion (PiP) – Postage Due Amnesty






Three different self-adhesive labels used on large envelopes fully paid at old rates that became underpaid on new rates due to size.


